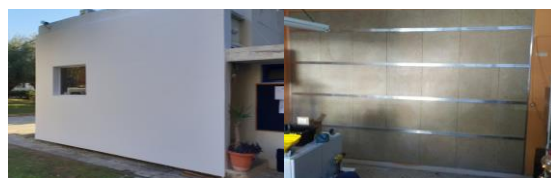
All the works were done according to the specific rehabilitation design for each demo building, considering the most performing solutions, demo site requirements, but also architects', engineers' and our Advisors' experience.
